## Introduction

In addition to the ŚATA-LAKṢA-GĪTĀ-LEKHANA-MAHĀ-YAJÑĀ program, we have introduced the harināma lekhana mahā-yajña program. Under the śata-lakṣa-gītā-lekhana, individuals are encouraged to write one or two verses from the Gita every day.

Once all the verses of the Gita have been written, the writing book will be offered to Sri RadhaMadhava in the Temple of Vedic Planetarium (TOVP), and the writers will retain the book as a lifelong memento. We also urge participants to write one Mahamantra (Hare Krishna Hare Krishna Krishna krishna Hare Hare. Hare Rama Hare Rama Rama Rama Hare Hare) daily, alongside the Gita verses, in a separate notebook provided for this purpose. After completing the writing of the Gita and the Mahamantra, these books will be brought to Mayapur to be offered to Sri SriRadhaMadhava when they are relocated to the TOVP.

The Gita writing book can be taken back by the writers to their respective homes as a cherished item for their own lives and future generations. However, the Harinam writing books will be kept in Mayapur, under a dome in the TOVP campus. This location will be open to visitors for many years to come, allowing them to witness the ten million people who wrote the Holy Name in celebration of Lord Sri Krishna's 5250th birth anniversary.

We kindly request those who have registered for the Śata-lakṣa-gītā-lekhana-mahā-yajña to also write one Maha mantra daily. This practice will bring immense good fortune by regularly engaging with the holy name through writing.
